Part 4

Fall of the (NSS) Empire 1970-2000

During the 1960s NSS had been dominant in the industry, but there were several signs of problems coming. Besides the sudden emergence of multiple screens popping up at theaters, another problem was also rising.

Andrew Kuehn, who had been trained at NSS, went to work for MGM and then in 1967 broke off to form Kaleidoscope and basically revolutionized the trailer industry and took a major bite out the trailer business that had been an anchor for NSS.





The board at NSS could see rapid changes going on. They made another brilliant move in 1969 that actually kept them more up to what those changes were. They purchased National Theatre Supply Co. which was the largest supplier of theatre projectors and sound equipment. This gave them an inside track on the direction of theatres.



The 1970s was like someone switched on the light. Suddenly, the race was on to see how many screens could be controlled under one roof. 4-plex, 6-plex, 8-plex, etc. Multiscreen theaters became the rage and every major city had to have them. Each new multiplex that popped up reduced the amount posters that were used to advertise. While the lobbies were a little larger, by the time you put up a poster for each screen and one for the next feature coming, very little room was left for all the other variety of sizes – especially for numerous titles.

Retreat

Orders drastically fell off, but that was just the beginning of the problems. They could simply adjust the number of posters printed. The problem was that they were under contract to stock EVERY SIZE whether it was used or not to every major movie studio. So, if no one used a 30x40 any more, it didn't matter, they had to print and keep them in stock for their entire region... just in case. Designing, printing, storage and labor mounted up rapidly.

By the late 1970s, NSS tried to restructure as a cost saving measure. In 1977, new computer programs combined trailer, poster and accessory material into a single computerized program. You will notice mid 1977 that the old NSS ##/## system changed to a 6 digit system to consolidate the three.



By 1980, they began closing warehouses and enlarging territories to compensate. But the pull toward multiplexes was far too strong. The 1980s saw the rise of the Megaplexes. By mid 1980s, it was not hard to find multiplex theaters with 12, 16 and a few up to 20 screens, rapidly eliminating most single or double screen theaters.

As it came time to renew contracts, NSS refused and in 1984, NSS relinquished all exclusive studio contracts for producing, stocking and servicing movie posters back to the individual studios.

This didn't mean that they stopped, they just gave up exclusivity. This eliminated the need to print, stock and store masses of posters that were not needed. Warehouses began to close leaving only 3 offices left. NSS remained a printer and distributor on a non-exclusive basis. But the **writing was on the wall.**

And not just for NSS !! As soon as the studios regained control, they realized that they had to immediately cut cost or they would be right back in trouble like NSS was. So, they eliminated all other standard sizes except the one sheet. They replaced all those sizes with a mini-sheet that varied in size. Then they did the one thing that sends shivers down the spine of every true movie poster collector..... THEY CHANGED THE SIZE (NOoooooo!)

Before 1984, the first question any collector would ask about authenticity.. **What is the size?** (27x41). That extra inch moved the printing from a commercial printer to an industrial printer – a LOT more difficult and costly. By reducing them to 27x40, they could shop around for prices. Great for them .. But for collectors, it created a true horror!!!!! It made them the same size as REPRINTS!!!

NSS continued to operate under this situation releasing their last distribution list in 1999 (we have that list on file). In 2000, Technicolor purchased National Screen Service and after utilizing all the areas they needed, they closed it down.

Brief final analysis

Our hobby owes its existence primarily to the National Screen Service. When NSS took control of movie posters in 1940 and eliminated the independent film poster exchanges, it caused literally millions of movie posters to become available to collectors. Granted, a large number of those went to the dump, but this is when movie poster collecting was really brought to light.


A few independent poster exchanges actually opened up to sell directly to the public (I believe that one is still actually open, or it was the last time I checked)

Then again during the scale down and closing of NSS warehouses in the early 1980s to 1999 caused millions of posters to again become available. The movie poster hobby basically owes its existence to National Screen Service.

So, a salute to NSS! Without you the last 40+ years of our lives would have been very different.







As promised and on time, we are proud to share with you **THE BRAND NEW WINTER POSTER & RECORDS COLLECTION** - **with its 839 items** - available in the <u>NEW PRODUCTS</u> section.

It probably is the largest of all the collections added since the opening of the Gallery in 2011. This is mainly due to a recent trip in Tokyo where I (literally) unearthed hundreds of MOVIE posters; the vast majority of those having NEVER been offered by any of my competitors or in auctions. They cover all the major genres (Anime, Disney, Kaiju, Samurai, Pinky, Sexploitation, Western...)

A particular attention is to be given to the Japanese Press movie posters with incredible shapes and formats!

The Collection also features a very impressive selection of very rare Italian movie posters (many being linen backed).

The MUSIC and OTHERS categories are filled with concert, Advertising, Airlines-Travel, Olympics, Headshop-Psychedelic and Politics-Propaganda all as gorgeous as rare. Too many names and companies to list so I will let you enjoy the browsing.

The COMICS section may be the 'lightest' but still filled with very nice limited edition prints featuring The Fantastic Four and The Rocketeer.

The rarely featured RECORDS section is enriched with several live vinyls from The Police, Elvis Costello and The Doobie Brothers, all in perfect condition.

SHIPPING and INSURANCE. Good news, the bottleneck delays at New York postal warehouse seem to have receded. Insurance is mandatory for all international shipments (to be added after purchase based on amount).

As mentioned above, I will not sum up all the incredible new items uploaded in each of the main categories - **COMICS**, **MOVIES**, **MUSIC** and **OTHERS** (you can choose to browse by using the filter at the left edge and clicking on the **categories/subcategories** you prefer or by clicking on the click down box on the right) - as I prefer to let you browse them all **HERE**


Following is a sample of 20 posters - among the 839 you will hopefully enjoy and purchase from the <u>NEW PRODUCTS</u> section.

With many new posters added, <u>Brigitte Bardot</u> and <u>Alain Delon</u> cement their pole positions among the most represented actors in the Gallery. Here they are together on the cover for the Japanese movie program for the 1961 multi part historical comedy, <u>Les amours célèbres (Famous Love Affairs)</u>.

Many brand new limited edition prints can be found including the one painted (and hand signed) by Alex Ross revisiting <u>Snow White And The Seven Dwarfs</u>.

From <u>Disney Studios</u> to the <u>Anime</u> ones, there is only the Pacific ocean to cross. Rare orginal colorful poster for the 1975 <u>Toei Anime Festival</u> featuring <u>UFO Robot / Grandizer / Goldorak</u>.

Let's not forget the Comics universe and particularly Marvel's with <u>a series of 6 limited</u> <u>edition prints of The Fantastic Four by Des Taylor</u> including the one featuring the ever sublime (and always perfectly coiffed) Sue Storm aka The Invisible Woman.









Women do indeed pay particularly care about their hairdos yet not nearly as much as how their luscious behinds will look as they try on a new pair of jeans! Original advertising poster (circa 1975) for the <u>Levi's Jeans brand</u>.

During the 70's and 80's, advertisers were (thankfully) not shackled by the 'woke' rules which enslave our societies for the worst. How can one not smile with second degree detachment when looking at this vintage poster (circa early 80's) for the Hotfingers skiwear brand.


The devastating images of California are hard to watch especially when many of us know people affected directly by the abysmal incompetence of the local authorities. We truly hope that the Golden state will resuscitate like a phoenix from its ashes and once again radiate its unique culture based on healthy nature. One sheet poster for Teenage Surfer Girls.

After Hawaï, California is indeed the second state affected by Dante like infernos, once again in 'mysterious' conditions as réservoirs were usually empty preventing firefighters to do as much as they should against nature. We also hope Maui will revive itself soon back to the technicolor glory of its heyday as show in Hawaiian Paradise Style and its colorful Swedish poster designed for the 1973 rerelease of the Musical. One of the many Elvis Presley posters added to the Collection.









After this dark interlude, let's turn to brighter colors especially when they are enhanced with Day-Glo inks and blacklight effects as can be appreciate don this impossible to find original head shop poster featuring Frank Zappa titled *Necessity Is The Mother Of Invention*.

Day-Glo inks and black light effects again with another ultra rare late 60's head shop poster. As it's untitled I christened it Big O.

Ultra rare is not an overly used adjective when one talks about one of the most iconic Italian movie posters ever printed, i.e. the large 2 panel poster for Blow-Up painted by Maestro Ercole Brini. The poster is in truly incredible condition.








Another as rare as striking beauty from the late 60's is this poster called a Ready Made; a printing process in which the artist experiments different ideas superposing images. I could find several of those (printed to less than 10 copies each) by David Singer, one of the most important Artists of the Fillmore poster scene. This one is visual mash-up from designed he did for the BG 196 and BG 243 Fillmore posters. A true Museum piece.

My other favorite Artists from the Fillmore poster scene is <u>Randy Tuten</u>, a good friend of the Gallery's and a Master at mixing fonts and colors. This poster was create for the second series of shows given by <u>Led Zeppelin at the Fillmore West</u> featuring a comic looking avocado. This should have been the first of a series of posters featuring fruits and veggies but Bill Graham killed the idea! This is the original first print, numbered BG 170-OP1 in the Fillmore West/BG series.

From comical characters, we move to one of the most terrifying ever: Ghidorah, essential monster from the <u>Kaiju genre</u>. Ultra rare original Japanese from 1964 for <u>Ghidorah The</u> Three-Headed Monster.

Among the many unique posters found in Tokyo one I had seen listed or reproduced in any book is the one for <u>Logan's Run</u>, the 1976 cult Sci-Fi movie featuring a calendar style design!










That movie features a surveillance state and brutal police spying on all our movements. We much prefer another police, <u>The Police</u> whose unique sounds particularly played made them one of the best ever bands as can be heard on this 1979 show captured on the <u>Caught In The Act</u> bootleg LP.

Majestic darkness enhancing the original concert poster for <u>ZZ Top</u>'s 1974 Seattle show featuring a beardless Billy Gibbons.

Texans are tough people and not just as guitar slingers but also as gunslingers. The Professionals is one of my all-time favorite Westerns thanks to Burt Lancaster and Lee Marvin. What a joy to have found under a massive pile this complete Japanese Press kit including 4 double sided gatefold inserts. Never seen. Never listed in any databases or books. Another Gallery exclusive.








Another Gallery exclusive is the set of 2 Japanese posters (sold separately) for the original release of <u>Rude Boy</u> starring <u>The Clash</u>. I already sold one copy of the blue poster (with Paul Simonon) but had never even knew the existence of a second poster featuring Ray Gange.

Among an avalanche of catastrophic and apocalyptic conflicts, it is even more vital that we remove ourselves from the surrounding darkness by harboring positive thoughts and speech as well as evading to more luminous places where we can recharge our souls and live *The Good Life* as we are being invited on this <u>American Airlines</u> poster.




This month's showcase - movie posters for kids of all ages



EXPERIENCE

I have been linen backing for over two years, after I retired. I have completed over 100 poster restorations for Morris Everett. I started this business with the help of Morris. He gave me posters to learn the process; and once perfected, I gained his confidence to back his poster collection. I was an executive manager because of my constant process improvement skills and transferred those skills in my linen backing business.

PROCESS

With regards to linen backing. I linen back using conservation techniques. What does that mean? It means I wash EVERY poster, first step is to deacidfy, this opens up the paper fibers to allow the paper bleach to remove stains, toning, water damage, etc. The poster is then mounted on acid free Japanese paper, and 12oz. Canvas. Once dry the poster is then touched up with water color pencils. The process is fully reversible.

PRICING

I have set up my pricing so that almost any poster can be linen backed. My pricing includes a full bath (photo on right shows water after a poster bath) and deacidification of the poster. It includes a light bleaching to remove the mold, and toning to bring back the colors and the whiteness of the paper, then a PH balance bath to neatralize the paper. The poster is then mounted on acid free Japanese Masa paper and mounted on 12 oz. cotton backing. The price also includes minor tape removal, and water color touch ups along the fold lines. All anyone has to do is contact me for pricing.




